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Friday Uniform:

- Golf Shirt
- Track Pants (to be worn with the golf shirt)
- White Caps (to be worn on Fridays; sun hats are an alternative)
- White and Black Socks

Monday, Tuesdays Thursday:

- Top: Girls should wear grey dresses with short sleeves. On Tuesday, they should switch to grey dresses with long sleeves. Boys should wear light grey trousers with a short-sleeve on Mondays AND Thursdays long-sleeve white shirt depending on the weather.
- Bottoms: For Wednesday, boys and girls should wear track pants with a golf shirt. On Thursday, grey trousers or grey dresses should be worn.
- Footwear: Black socks are to be worn from Monday to Thursday.
- Outerwear: A navy-blue jacket should be worn daily to complement the uniform.
- Winter Option: Track pants can be worn every day during winter for added warmth.
- WEDNESDAYS are for trackpants or Friday skirts and golf shirts

Friday:

- Top: Both boys and girls should wear golf shirts.
- Navy blue shorts\Friday skirts
- Footwear: White socks and white Tekkies should be worn on Fridays.
- Headwear: White caps are preferred, but sun hats can be worn as an alternative.

Additional Notes:

- Jersey: A navy-blue jersey with yellow stripes is part of the uniform but should be brought for logo printing at an additional cost. (sweater vests for summer)
 - Blazer: Boys and girls should wear the navy blazer with gold accents or trim as part of their formal uniform.
 - Headwear Options: Beanies (woollen hats) or sun hats are available and should be worn according to the weather and the school's policy.
 - NOTE: BLAZERS TO BE WORN BY PRIMARY STUDENTS ONLY.
